East's 2♠ overcall of the 1NT opener shows a hand with opening values 11-15 hcps and 5+ spades.

West's 10 hcps and 3-card spade support make it worth an invitational raise to 3. East with 14 hcps, 6 spades and a singleton heart can now bid the game.

When South leads ♥Q North must overtake with ♥A as he knows that East must hold ♥K. Despite seeing East's singleton ♥K appear, North should opt for a passive ♥2 return because opening a second side suit is more likely to benefit declarer than the defence.

On this hand, declarer clears trumps and loses only two more tricks to North's ♠A and ♠A. Contract made.

South's double of the 1NT opener shows a balanced hand with 16-18 hcps.

West's 2. is a weak takeout showing 5+ clubs but with few hcps. With North having only 4 hcps that may well be the end of the auction.

North's probable lead is ♥4. Declarer can take the trick with ♥A and then try a club finesse. When this succeeds, he can return via ♠A to repeat the finesse.

Ten tricks can be made, losing only ♣A and ◆AK. If South does not take ♣A on the second round of trumps, eleven tricks can be made by discarding a diamond on dummy's winning spades.

West's 2♠ overcall of the 1NT opener shows a hand with opening values 11-15 hcps and 5+ spades. East should pass and not make any attempt to "rescue" partner.

When North leads ◆Q South must overtake with ◆A as he knows West must hold ◆K, and then return ♠8 to prevent dummy ruffing diamonds. When declarer leads ♣Q North should suspect that it is a singleton, so he should win ♣A and then continue with diamonds.

Unfortunately for declarer there is no entry to dummy to cash club tricks, but he will lose only one trick in hearts to just make the contract.

North's 2 ◆ overcall of the 1NT opener shows a hand with opening values 11-15 hcps and 5+ diamonds.

East does not have a good lead, ♥2 is probably the best choice. When East sees dummy's hearts, he can work out that partner probably has four hearts headed by ♥K and that declarer has a singleton. If declarer plays dummy's ♥Q West should play ♥A, otherwise ♥J, to win the trick and then return a passive ♥3.

The missing honours in clubs, diamonds, and spades all sit well for declarer, so that an overtrick is possible.

East's double of the 1NT opener shows a balanced hand with 16-18 hcps.

South's 2♠ is a weak takeout showing 5+ spades but with few hcps. West's double is for penalties suggesting that E/W may not be able to make a game themselves but there is a good chance of defeating 2♠.

West's best lead looks to be ♣4 promising partner an honour in clubs. Declarer has nothing to lose by playing ♣Q to try the finesse but loses to East's ♣K. East should now lead ♠A followed by ♣10; he is asking partner to lead diamonds back through North's ♠Q.

The best outcome for declarer is four spade tricks and two outside aces for two down vulnerable, -500.

South's 2♥ overcall of the 1NT opener shows a hand with opening values 11-15 hcps and 5+ hearts. North should pass and not make any attempt to "rescue" partner.

West will probably choose to lead his singleton ◆2. East's ◆Q will be taken by declarer's ◆A.

There is no reason to clear trumps because there is no outside suit to be established. Instead declarer should look to other suits. The bidding suggests it is probable that East has *A, but a finesse would work if West has *Q, so *2 lead to dummy's *J may be good. West wins the trick with *A, cashes *K, and leads another diamond for West to ruff. West must lead either spades or clubs, so declarer can now cash dummy's *A and *K, then play *10 on which he can discard his last spade. Now declarer will win five of the last six tricks to make the contract.
