## TEAMS V PAIRS

What's the main difference in scoring between Teams and Pairs?

In Pairs scoring all boards carry the same % score. ie. A 20 board session all boards are worth a maximum of 5%

In Teams this is not the case.

Each board is scored on its own merit.

ie. In a 20 board match you could make an overtrick on 18 boards gaining 1 imp per board, but on the  $19^{th}$  and  $20^{th}$  board you missed the vulnerable slam and lose 24 imps on just these 2 hands.

This score equates to around 47.5% The same scores in Pairs would give you  $18 \times 100\%$  and  $2 \times 0\% = 90\%$ 

So what are the main differences between play Pairs and Teams, and how should we adapt our Bidding and Play?

## **PLAY**

In Teams, do not put your contract in danger for an overtrick. While at pairs you need to make as many tricks as possible, in teams making your contract in paramount.

## **Bidding**

Thin games.

Push to game on lower point counts or good distribution, the plusses out weigh the negatives.

You hold this hand below

- **★** 853
- **♥** AT
- **♦** 97
- ♣ KQJT63

Partner has opened 1NT. In pairs you should Pass In teams you should raise to 3NT

If you had Passed and everyone else had bid game making 9 tricks you would loose 6 Imps (250 nv) loose 10 Imps (450 v)

If you had Passed and everyone else had bid game making 8 tricks you would gain 5 Imps (170 nv) gain 6 Imps (220 v)

So if a game has a 50% chance of making and you bid it, over the course of 10 hands

Pairs you will gain on 5 hands and lose on 5 hands. Teams NV you will gain 30 Imps and lose 25 Imps Teams V you will gain 50 Imps and lose 30 Imps
