

Home Page

The entry point for Gainesville's web site contains the following principal elements:

Menu Buttons – on the left side of the screen, there is a vertical row of menu buttons guiding the user to other places on the web site. This document will describe the functions behind each one of these buttons. The buttons look like this:



News Items – in the center and right side of the screen are news items. These items will be current and will change frequently. When a news item is replaced on the home page, it will be moved for a time to the News Page.

Results – a link to the results of the two most current games will be on the home page. It looks like this:

Place your cursor on the date in the box and left mouse click to go to the Results Page for that date.

Rank Changes – Members who have advanced in rank in the previous month will be listed here. A running summary of the current year’s rank changes can be found by clicking on 2013 Rank Changes.

The News Page contains older news items that have been rolled off the Home Page. These will be kept for a time before being deleted permanently.





In the left column, the pairs are listed by rank, pair number, names of the players and the direction in which they played. The middle column, in this example, shows all the boards played by Joyce and Mary Ann, their opponents' pair number, names, contract, tricks made, score and points.

On the right hand side of the page, there are three boxes. Starting from the top, you see the number of boards played in the game:

Finally, if there is more than one section playing on that date, you select the section from the top menu bar. In this example, there are two sections: Section A and Section F.
