2025 NAP Qualifying

During the months of June, July & August, HBC will offer multiple North American Pairs (NAP) Qualifying games. By participating in these games and doing reasonably well, players may qualify for both Unit 168 and District 4 level NAP finals which will be conducted in September/October. Many of these Unit/District 4 level finals will be held at HBC and will serve as qualifying events for the National NAP finals. NAP qualifying games played at clubs award 50% red and 50% black points.

Starting this year, ACBL has changed the Flights used for NAP qualification as follows: Championship Flight - open to all players regardless of masterpoints; Flight A - players with fewer than 6000 points; Flight B - players with fewer than 3000 points; and Flight C - Non Life Masters (NLM) with fewer than 750 points. Eligibility for these Flights is determined by the ACBL point update accomplished on May 6, 2025 - any points earned after that date are not used in determining Flight eligibility.

Due to these Flight standards, some regular HBC games will have different point ranges during the June - August period (some 0-500 games become 0-750 NLM, some 0-1500 become 0-3000, etc.).
