

## SOCIAL SWISS MIXER GAME

**The Bridge Mixer** is a Swiss game format designed to be a more fun, less competitive game whereby all members of the club can participate and be successful. It is like a Swiss Mentor Game. Each team will be made up of the following players but you sign up individually.

### JUNIOR MENTOR PAIR

Player #1: Beginner	(0-75 masterpoints)
Player #2: Intermediate	(250-750 masterpoints)

### SENIOR MENTOR PAIR

Player #3: Advanced Beginner	(75-250 masterpoints)
Player #4: Open	(750 + masterpoints)

[The masterpoint limits may have to be adjusted depending on sign-ups]

The beginner and intermediate player will form 1 pair with the intermediate player always sitting in the East position and the beginner player always sitting in the West position. The advanced beginner and open player will form the 2<sup>nd</sup> pair with the open player always sitting in the North position and the advanced beginner always sitting in the South position. Senior Mentor Pairs from each team will play the Junior Mentor Pair from the opposing team. The Open player will serve as the team captain and will be responsible for scoring for the team and to make sure that the team is at the correct table, players in the correct positions and to answer any questions.

Everyone should sign up individually as you do not need a partner or a team. We will choose the teams on the day of the event by drawing a name from 4 separate baskets. Teams will be posted and given a home table.
