Tip of the week – Look at the texture of your hand to help you judge the contract

When faced with close decisions look at the make up of your hand to decide whether to play in a suit contract or no-trumps.

For no-trumps look for Queens, Jacks, Tens, Nines and long minor suits. For suit contracts look for Aces, Kings, singletons and voids
