Scoring errors:

- Please be careful entering and verifying the scores on the Bridgemates. Please call the Director in charge of that game with corrections during the game.
- Before you leave the club on game day, consider getting a score printout, checking scores and reporting discrepancies to the Director. Errors are much easier to correct before scores have been submitted.
- You have probably noticed that Common Game is ferreting out possible scoring errors. You may have received emails alerting you to the fact that a particular score is unlikely or impossible. You should report these discrepancies or others discovered after the fact to the Director of the game in which you played, NOT to the club email or phone! Your directors are happy to make the appropriate corrections but need to do it in a timely fashion. Your best chance of having this happen is to report the discrepancy to the director. Director contact information is on the game schedule on the club website home page (www.bridgewebs.com/jacksonvilleschool).
- Scoring changes received after you leave the club on game day will be reflected in the result that is reported to the ACBL at the end of the month and will be posted in a Corrected printout on the club bulletin board. Corrected results will not appear in the Results section of the club website, nor in Common Game results.
