**JSOB Website:** We didn't publish a 2021 directory, but an online directory along with other good stuff is on the website ([www.bridgewebs.com/jacksonvilleschool](http://www.bridgewebs.com/jacksonvilleschool)). Here's how to use it:



- Create an account. Click on Membership in the left-hand menu. Read the instructions on the right!
- Log in. If you have not created an account, or don't remember your password, click Set/Reset Password.
- Once you have logged in, look at the tabs across the top of the page.
  - You can go straight to your Personal Analysis.
  - You have access to the Member List (who needs a printed directory?!).
  - In the Account tab, you can view and edit your member information. Consider uploading a photo, it will appear on your Results page for every game! You can make changes to your name, address, phone, and options such as directory list, mailing list, and what information about you is displayed. More information about how to use the Account page is on the right side of the page—please read it before making any changes.
- While you are on the site (you don't need to be logged in), take a few minutes to click on each left hand menu option and see what's there—bylaws, history, newsletters, tournament results, a lot of good stuff!
