

Game time is 6:30 (table fee \$7.00), out by 9:30. Get your team together or let Anne Landry or Jan Madsen know if you would like to play, and they will try to find you a team. Even if you have not signed up, bring your team, and come on in. Mentors and Mentees, why not form a team with another mentoring pair?

Chat Bridge: As you are discovering, bridge has many facets. In addition to bidding, defense, and play of the hand, we must learn table etiquette, conventions, scoring, completing a convention card, etc.

A good place to begin putting this knowledge into practice is at Saturday morning Chat Bridge.

Experienced players are on hand to answer your questions as you bid and play. This is a good opportunity to bring your long-time party bridge friend and introduce them to duplicate; update your bidding if you learned to played bridge in the past and want to get back into the game; meet new people and find partnerships; and expose yourself to new concepts. Chat is held most Saturday mornings (check the calendar on the club website) from 9:30 to about noon. You don't need to bring a partner. The fee is \$7.00 for a relaxing time to play hands, in a non-rushed and comfortable environment, and to ask those questions that help you better grasp this fascinating game. Note that on third Saturdays Chat Bridge is replaced by Nancy Stein's Third Saturday lesson, pitched at advancing beginning players.
