- Are you and your partner confused about how to fill out the new convention card? Louise Fontecchio will return from playing in the Gatlinburg Regional using the new card. Louise will share her insights into why it was changed and some of the new provisions. Working with your partner to put your agreements in writing will improve your partnership communication!

**More Master Points!** Effective February 27, face-to-face games began awarding more points. Your points will be increased by a factor of up to 50% depending on the number of boards played. So, playing at the club is now worth more points than online games. This upgrade applies only to regular club games (labeled "XXXday Pairs" on the club calendar), not to special games that award extra masterpoints. Your upgraded score will not show on the club printout. To find your upgraded:

- Go to ACBL.org;
- Click on Menu (top of page);
- Click on Results (left hand side of page);
- Click on Live for Clubs; Input "Jacksonville Sch of Bridge" in Search block;
- Scroll to game you are interested in to check your adjusted score. It should reflect either a 44% or 50% adjustment, depending on if you played 26 or 27 boards.

**Please Be Scent-sitive:** Some people have extreme sensitivity to fragrances (colognes, perfumes, body wash, or lotions). Because duplicate bridge requires players to be near each other, those who suffer from fragrance-related reactions cannot avoid those who are wearing them. Among the commonly reported symptoms are intense headaches (including migraines) and breathing-related problems. For those who suffer from this sensitivity, the issue is more serious than simply disliking a certain smell. It is a real health problem. Please refrain from wearing scented products when you come to the bridge club!
