JSOB Directory: Are you wondering what to do without your printed JSOB directory? The online version is always up to date. And if you prefer a paper copy, you can download and print it! Barbara Parke tested out this process and commented, "That was great information...it was easy peasy to use (and very interesting, as you said)." The first step is to create an account:

- Go to the club website, https://www.bridgewebs.com/jacksonvilleschool/
- Click on Membership in the left menu.
- Log in to your existing account. If you have not yet created an account, or don't remember how to log in, click Set/Reset Password. Follow the instructions.
- Once you have created an account, you can use either your email or ACBL number as your username to log in.
- Once you have logged in, look at the tabs across the top of the page.
 - You have access to the up-to-the-minute Member List (who needs a printed directory?!). Click on the green arrow to the right of the Search box to download the list.
 - You can go straight to your Personal Analysis.
 - In the Account tab, you can view and edit your member information: name, address, phone, and options such as mailing list and what information about you is displayed.
 More information about how to use the Account page is on the right side of the Account page—please read it before making any changes.
 - Consider uploading a photo, it will appear on your Results page after every game!

While you are on the site (you don't need to be logged in), click on each left menu option and see what's there—bylaws, history, newsletters, tournament results, a lot of good stuff! As always, if you see anything that needs to be corrected or changed, please let us know. You can do so by sending a message in the Contact Us area in the left menu.
