Clive and his teammates won First Place in Flight B, accumulating 26.8 Gold Master Points. Ted, Don, Marty and Ed won First Place in Flight C and were awarded 20 Gold/Red Master Points. Bobbie and her teammates tied for 3/4 place, earning 10.72 Gold Master Points. The A team, Ann, Mark, Joe, and Jim, placed fourth overall. NAP Qualifier and Colored Points (Applicable to All Players, Including Beginners!): On June 3 the club is holding a North American Pairs (NAP) qualifying game. This is a national competition in which, if you qualify by doing well in the club game, you can play at the district level. (We are District 9, unit 128 of the ACBL.) The district contest will be held in October at a date TBA. The winner of the District 9 contest goes to the Nationals in Spring 2022 in Reno with a cash award to help defray expenses! More importantly to those striving to make Life Master, 1/2 of the points awarded on June 3 will be red.

For other colored point opportunities, check the club calendar and watch for **STaC** Games in August. They award silver points. In November, a **Regional Tournament** is scheduled in Daytona Beach. Gold
