A Few Tips for Playing Bridge on BBO

Bridge teacher and author, Barbara Seagram, recently published some tips for playing bridge on BBO, as follows:

- If there is a screen open that is blocking the cards, just click on it and it will close.
- If you need to review the auction, click on the left side of the cards where it gives what the contract is. e.g. 4H. That will bring up the auction, any time during the hand. Then click on it to close it.
- If you want to see what others did on a hand right after you finish playing it...go to HISTORY (tab on right) and then at top of that box, click on Other Tables, you will see what others did.
- Go to ACCOUNT (tab on right) and put in your first and last name. It is SO much easier for people to know who you are and chat at the table. And please say HELLO to your opponents.
- Sometimes you are chatting away and your message is going to LOBBY. No one hears you. Important that you click on the blue button at bottom left and choose TABLE.
- If you want to speak privately to an opponent, click the blue button and then on their name. Their account box comes up at top right of screen. You can message them privately in that message line and switch back to TABLE Chat when you wish.
