Congress Food

Unfortunately because it is the school holidays we cannot provide catered food in the Pavilion, although it is the main school restaurant.

We thus suggest that you bring your own food which you can eat on the premises. The school grounds are very attractive and if it is not raining you can picnic in the open air. **Please Note:** because of pupils' allergies the school is a nut free zone. You may not bring in foods containing nuts.

Alternatively the Abingdon town square is less than a 10 minute walk away and there are multiple lunch sources, from Greggs, through sandwich and coffee bars to pubs and restaurants. You may wish to buy lunch here before the morning sessions to save time at lunch time. A walking map is on the right. Ask Google Maps for directions from the Amey Theatre to Abingdon town square. Bath Street is a pedestrian precinct.



Further away, a five minute drive will take you to a Waitrose store with free parking while you are shopping. The route is shown below. Note that there is no exit for vehicles from Park Road on to Stratton Way.
