John Deech Trophy (2024/25)

This is result of the John Deech Challenge Pairs which ran from September 2024 to May 2025. To feature you must have played in at least 60% of the events so far. This ladder used 'positional' scoring. The lowest pair in a session scores 2 and each position above scores 2 more. So you score more, say, for coming first in a big field than a small one.

Once you have played in more than 5 events only your best 5 are included. You must be a club member to be eligible to win the trophy and/or cash prizes.
