Newcomers Pairs

This event is planned for 1st December and has attracted a good number of entrants

Members Meeting and Technology Day

It was proposed to hold a Members day to improve communications within the County whereby clubs could send representatives to discuss any issues with the Committee and see demonstration of equipment such as dealing machines. This could be followed by a bridge session

Proposed Grants to Clubs

A strategy is needed to encourage more clubs to become teaching clubs and provide lessons and hopefully increase club members

A Teachers Training Course will be held in Somerset in 2020 and the SCBA will encourage and if necessary assist financially, clubs who wish to participate. A program of lessons is available to all clubs

Many clubs do not have the facilities to run courses. Frome and Winscombe are the only clubs known to offer lessons. Ceri Pierce has prepared a questionnaire/survey to be issued to affiliated clubs to ascertain whether they are prepared to enter the scheme.

The recognised problem is players moving from beginner status to playing at club level

Grants to be offered to affiliated clubs as an incentive to provide teaching courses
