I think it's true to say there's a fair amount going on at Somerset Contract Bridge Association and this newsletter is to bring members squarely up-to-date.


Committee

In previous years entrants have visited from across the UK and possibly beyond. We are hoping to continue the success of the event.


Once again we are including a 9 High event. Do please consider joining us; many new players or less experienced players may wish to join an event that will be devoid of the dreaded experts!
