

and any mess is disposed of.

Sugar Orchard Field is next to a very busy road, so any children must be supervised at all times. The entrances will not be manned.

Do we need to pay?

There is no entrance fee, but donation buckets will be available if you can spare any change. Donations will go to the Village Hall charity fund, which not only pays for the upkeep and improvement of the hall, but also the maintenance of the village defibrillators, along with funding events such as village day and bonfire night.
