Washington Bridge League – September 2021 Board Meeting Minutes

Secretary's Report

The Board approved the minutes of the August 2021 meeting.

Online Unit Game and Treasurer's Report

Chris Miller, Unit Game Manager, was not present at the meeting. Herb provided an update for both the unit game and treasurer's report.

Since our last meeting, Thursday night game attendance has been flat. Herb provided total table counts for the past few games: 44, 44, 42, and 45 respectively. The Monday, September 6 game was cancelled due to low attendance (re: Labor Day and Rosh Hashanah), but bounced back to six tables on September 13 and seven tables on September 20. Looking forward, Herb anticipates net profits in the month of September, around \$600-800.

Thanks to online unit game revenues, the WBL has continued to contribute to the Capital Area Food Bank (\$3000 total at this time) and to pay the regular unit game caddies (Alan Crank and David Solomon).

Lastly, Herb said he would reach out to Chris Miller to discuss the possibility of Alan Crank and/or David Solomon going to Ohr Kodesh to clean the bidding boxes and remove batteries from bridgemates in anticipation of reopening.

Reopening/Future Plans

The Board discussed resumption of face-to-face unit games and tournaments.

Hadi reported that the ACBL is in the process of developing online district-wide team and pair games that clubs would administer. These games would be open to all members of District 6 and to other places, as permissible under the ACBL visitor policy. The WBL would need to create a committee for it and designate a coordinator in order to participate. Barbara Doran is currently writing the Conditions of Contest. Hadi asked any interested volunteers to reach out to him via email.

Hadi informed meeting attendees of ACBL's new COVID protocols, posted on Sept 3 2021:

ACBL has also recently announced that it will staff sectionals and regionals that meet criteria for safe return.

Linda has been in communication with Karen Maxin at the Schweinhaut Senior Center. Although the building is not renting to outside organizations at this time, Karen said that the WBL is welcome to provide future sectional dates. Bob suggested we pay special attention to planning publicity for our first sectional to increase the chance that it is successful. Mary urged that plans for reopening face-to-face bridge focus initially on reopening the unit game, which poses much less risk of substantial financial loss than a poorly attended sectional. Herb added that unit game rent costs about \$400, whereas rent for a sectional weekend costs about \$3000.

Board members agreed that reopening the unit game would serve as a good indication of how many players would attend a sectional. Herb added that Gene Schuyler's in-person game now requires reservations to ensure adequate game attendance. Alex Stille suggested that a planning check-list be made prior to organizing our first sectional; Bob noted this would be a task for the tournament committee.

[ADDENDUM: In a Sept 24, 2021 email exchange, a majority of the Board agreed that the state of pandemic made it inadvisable for us to commit to holding a January sectional.]

Committee Assignments

The Board decided to leave existing memberships largely unchanged. Highlighted names in the chart indicate new additions. The Board agreed to form a single Communications Committee (formerly the Electronic Communications & Communications Committee). In the Executive session, the Board decided to invite the three members of the Conduct and Ethics Committee (David Marshall; Barry Falgout; Merril Hirsh) whose terms were set to expire this year to serve another two-year term (until 2023).

Alex Stille suggested there be a review of all existing committees, e.g. their specific intent and span of control. Linda proposed, and Alex Stille agreed, that he chair the review process. Bob has since agreed to work with Alex on that review.
